- Apprenticeship is a 12 consecutive month period. At the end of that time, the apprentice may remain an Open rider. In this case, previous Non Pro earnings will be backed out for eligibility purposes. If the Apprentice does not remain an Open rider, the Apprentice must then re-apply for Non Pro status and is subject to the Non Pro conditions. Any monies won during the 12 consecutive months Apprenticeship shall be applied to their Non Pro eligibility.
