WHAT IS IT?

This program is designed to showcase the hardworking individuals in the Oceania region that make reining possible. There will be three awards: Volunteer of the Year plaque, Professional of the Year plaque, Non Pro of the Year plaque. There will be one plaque in each division awarded each year.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The plaques will be awarded on a rotating country basis, starting with Australia, then moving to Japan, South Africa, Thailand, and China, in this order. If a country drops their affiliation, the awards will move to the next country in line. If a new country affiliates, they will jump in line behind the last country in the rotation. All nominees must be current NRHA members in good standing and active members of an affiliate, nominated by an NRHA member in good standing.

Professional of the Year: Professionals nominated for this award have been exemplary in their volunteering, youth coaching, and leadership inside and outside of the arena. They are an active member of their affiliate and are constantly looking for ways to grow reining in Oceania.
