* Number of horses to be used for computation shall be those horses actually competing; excluding the number of horses entered but scratched from competition.

Ex: If 20 riders show in Green Reiner 1, 1st will receive 20 points, 2nd -19 points, 3rd-18 points, etc.

Neither a no score nor a 0 are eligible to receive points in an NRHA Green Reiner class; however, this does not alter the scale of points for placing.
