#### **Event Results**

As technology becomes more efficient, so does NRHA! Through ReinerSuite, event approvals and event results can be processed by show secretaries immediately when they have the information or upon an event completion. NRHA show secretaries now have the ability to download an API into their show programs that can check eligibility in real time and through ReinerSuite can upload a csv of their event results immediately upon the event completing, leading to very little time between an event finishing and the results being published for members to see. # Dressing to Impress

Schooling is a part of many reiners process when participating in events, and in many times can be very beneficial for not only our horses, but also us as riders. However, it is important to remember that when you are schooling in an official NRHA class, you are representing the sport to all that are watching you. Even if you are planning to zero your score immediately, please take care to dress yourself and your horse in a manner that is not only respectful to the judge who is present and judging you, but to the sport that you love and are representing (sometimes on a worldwide level if the event is being livestreamed).
