



Nominations FAQ

- **Who can nominate a horse?**
 - Active General, Non Pro, Professional, and Youth members in good standing are eligible to nominate a horse. Associate members are ineligible to nominate a horse.
- **Can more than one person nominate the same horse?**
 - Only one membership ID number can be used to nominate a horse.
- **Can any horse be nominated?**
 - Yes, any horse can be nominated, including grade horses.
- **Does the owner of the horse have to be listed as the nominator?**
 - No, the nominator does not have to own the horse.
- **Will the nominator still receive the 5% nominator incentive if they have sold the horse?**
 - Yes, the nominator will receive the incentive money if the horse wins money in the respective program and event for which they were nominated, even if the nominator no longer owns the horse.
- **Can a nominator be changed?**
 - No, once the nomination is finalized, the nominator cannot be changed.
- **When is the deadline to nominate?**
 - The deadline to nominate without penalty is January 10th.
- **Once my horse is nominated, is it automatically entered into the NRHA Futurity or Derby?**
 - No, once a nomination is completed, the horse is now eligible to be entered into the NRHA Futurity or Derby. To be fully entered, a completed entry form and the applicable fees must be submitted.
- **Can I still nominate a horse if I have not received the registration papers?**
 - Yes, the registration papers will be used to complete the NRHA competition license and can be turned in at any time.
- **How can I pay for my nomination?**
 - You can pay via valid credit card, cash, check, or wire transfer. All wire transfers must be submitted with a receipt stating the transfer was successful.
- **Do I have to nominate the horse into both the North American and European programs at the same time?**
 - No, an option for either program can be added at any time.

- **Do the sire and dam have to be nominated in order for their offspring to be nominated?**
 - No, this is not a requirement of the program.

- **Are there installment payment options?**
 - No, the nomination must be paid in full at the time of nomination.
