**General Membership** – Must be paired with a Non Pro Declaration or Pro Card in order to show.

Below assumes only general class eligibility based on membership type.

**Pro Members** – Can only show in Open classes.

-Horse must be owned by a current general or youth member, not an associate member.

Non Pro Members – May show in NP and Open classes (Except Rookie Pro)

- Horse must be owned by a current general or youth member, solely owned by Non Pro themselves or an immediate family member.

**Youth Members** – May show in Youth, Category 10, and Open classes (Except Rookie Pro)

**Youth Non Pro** – May show in any class (Except Rookie Pro)

-- Horse must be owned by a current general or youth member, solely owned by the Youth themselves or an immediate family member.

**Associate Members** – Can show in Green Reiner, Ride & Slide, and Para Reining classes ONLY. Can only be an owner of a horse if the horse is shown ONLY in Green Reiner, Ride & Slide, or Para Reining.

Cannot add Non Pro onto an Associate membership. Must either choose to be an Associate or move to a General Non Pro. Associate members wanting to change to a General Non Pro must call or email the office to do so.

**Green Reiner & Ride & Slide NP** – Must be Non Pros. Unless is a Youth or Associate – then they must be NP eligible.

## No Ownership Restrictions:

**Category 10 & Para Reining** – No ownership is required. Horses do not need to have a competition license.

**Rookie 1/2/PT** – Must be Non Pros. Horse license is required but no ownership restrictions (Exhibitor does not need to own the horse themselves).

**Youth Rookie/Unrestricted Youth/Youth Short Stirrup** – Horse license is required but no ownership restrictions (Exhibitor does not need to own the horse themselves).
