Nomination FAQ

- Who can nominate a horse?
 - Active General, Non-Pro, Professional, and Youth members in good standing are eligible to nominate a horse. Associate members are ineligible to nominate.
- Can more than one person nominate the same horse?
 - Only one membership ID can be used to nominate a horse.
- Can any horse be nominated?
 - Yes, any horse can be nominated, including grade horses.
- Does the owner have to be listed as the nominator?
 - \circ $\,$ No, the nominator does not have to own the horse.
- Can a nominator be changed?
 - No, once the nomination is finalized, the nominator cannot be changed or transferred.
- When is the deadline to nominate?
 - \circ $\;$ The deadline to nominate without penalty is January 10th.
- Is my horse automatically entered into the NRHA Futurity, Derby, or 4-year-old only Division?
 - No, the nomination makes the horse eligible to be entered into the NRHA Futurity, Derby, or 4year-old only Division. To be fully entered, a completed entry form and the applicable fees must be submitted.
- Can I still nominate a horse if I have not received the registration papers?
 - Yes, you can still nominate without the registration papers. The horse will appear as pending until a copy of the papers is received.
- How can I pay for my nomination?
 - You can pay via a valid credit card, cash, check, or wire transfer. All wire transfers must be submitted with a receipt stating the transfer was successful.
- Do I have to nominate the horse for both the North American and European programs at the same time?
 - \circ $\,$ No, an option for either program can be added at any time.
- Do the sire and dam have to be nominated for their offspring to be nominated?
 - No, this is not a requirement of the program.
- Are there installment payment options?
 - \circ No, the nomination must be paid in full at the time of nomination.
- Does the NRHA nomination also include the National Reining Breeders Classic?
 - No, the NRHA nomination is only for the NRHA Futurity, Derby, and 4-year-old only Division.
 The NRBC nomination program is a separate program.
