## MEMBERSHIPS

### General

- Individual or Business Non-competing/Non-riding members (Owners and/or Breeders).
- General members can complete a license or nomination for their horses and participate in other NRHA Programs.
- Full NRHA rights, responsibilities, and voting privileges.

### Associate

- Individuals wanting to show or enter horses in Category 10 (entry-level) or Para Reining Classes only.
- Cannot vote, nominate, or officiate. Does not include copy of NRHA Reiner Magazine.

### Youth

- Anyone who is less than 18 years old who wants to compete.

### Youth Non Pro

- Anyone who is less than 18 years old who submits a Non Pro declaration and pays the membership fee associated with it in addition to a Youth membership.

### Non Pro

- Non Professional rider: must submit a Non Pro application and pay the fee.
- At time of application, the rider has not won more than \$200K in Open Reining competition and has not engaged in the following activities:
  - Training or showing astride in any equine discipline.
  - Giving instruction on the showing or training of a performance horse.
  - Sponsorships or endorsements unless approved due to celebrity status gained outside reining industry.

### Professional

- Anyone not eligible for Non Pro card. Must fill out and sign professional code of conduct and complete Professionals membership application.
- Has same privileges as General membership.
